

## Other Items

### Linking Hose \$10.00

Used to attach multiple Rain Barrels together. 4 feet in length by 1/2 inch in diameter

### Automatic Rain Water Diverter \$33.00

Automatically deflects water from a full barrel back to existing downspouts or drainage systems. Fits a 2X3 or 3x4 inch downspout.

### Flex Elbow \$10.00

Plastic flex elbow can be attached to the downspout to route rainwater into the Rain Barrel opening. Fits 2X3 inch or for \$18 a 3x4 inch downspout. Color: White.

### Wooden Pedestal \$27.00

A wooden stand for stabilizing and elevating the Rain Barrel. Extra height increases water pressure and provides better access to the lower valve. Made from upcycled lumber.

### Rain Barrel Netting \$10.00

This black plastic netting that comes with clips to hold it around the barrel. Plant any type of vine in the ground below and let it grow up the netting.

### Plant Hanger \$14.00

Made from stainless steel and aluminum strapping. Fit standard 4" diameter pots. Available in 30, 33, and 38 inch lengths.

### Potting Bench \$233

The potting bench is designed for the homeowner who lives in an apartment, condo or townhouse. The 30 gallon Blue Rain Barrel and the 50 gallon Brown or Terra Cotta Rain Barrel fit perfectly next to the Potting Bench.

### Upgrade to a larger style overflow for an additional \$24

During heavy downpours, rain barrels fill faster than a garden hose overflow can output excess water. Water can overflow through the top and puddle. The Wide Overflow Upgrade will channel away huge amounts of rainwater to help prevent puddling.

A Rain Barrel collects water from your roof downspouts and stores it for later use. Rainwater can be used for any non-potable purpose such as watering plants, washing cars, or bathing pets.



## Save Water!

Your Rain Barrel will collect the water on a rainy day and conserve it for use on a dry day. Rain Barrels conserve water.

## Save Money!

Save money on your water bill by using water stored in your Rain Barrel. Rain Barrels help lower costs (a Rain Barrel can save approximately 1,300 gallons of water during peak summer months).

## Save Landfill Space!

These Rain Barrels are made from **repurposed** or **upcycled** plastic food containers. The term UpCycle is the practice of taking something that is throwaway and repurposing it into something of greater utilization and intrinsic worth, in its second life.

These Rain Barrels are **repurposed** food quality high density polyethylene that were previously used to ship pickled food from overseas. They are cleaned and rinsed with rain water and a pH neutral soap and customized with fittings and screens for your use.

**These Rain Barrels are designed to leave out all year round.** The only thing you need to do to prepare for the winter season is to drain all the water out of them, open the shutoff valve, remove the linking fitting cap, remove any hoses, and leave them standing.

*All fittings are plastic, and are made in Indiana and Illinois using 40% recycled material.* Rain Barrels are approximately 21 inches in diameter and 34 inches in height. **Colors:** Gray, Terra-Cotta, Black, and Blue. *50 gallon only available in Terra-Cotta or Brown. 30 gallon only available in Blue.*

## Using Rain Barrel Water

- Water your flowers, trees, shrubs, and lawn.
- Wash your car, pets, tools and boots.
- **DO NOT DRINK WATER** from your rain barrel.
- **DO NOT COOK OR BATHE** with water from your rain barrel.
