

# RUMPKE WASTE & RECYCLING GUIDELINES

## WASTE COLLECTION

- Residents are asked to have all items at curbside the night before the scheduled Friday pick up.
- Waste may be placed in any designated waste receptacle, 35 gallon and 50 lbs maximum size. **Six cans or bags are allowed at the curb each week. Excess trash of 4 cans or bags for a total of 10 if called in advance.**
- Boxes, drums and barrels are not acceptable for waste and will be removed as trash and not replaced.
- 95 – gallon waste wheelers are available for rent by request. Contact Hidden Valley Lake office to order.
- Bulk materials such as drywall, concrete, bricks and dirt are not accepted.
- Loose materials such as shrubbery, leaves, branches and grass clippings are to be placed in bags and set out with your regular garbage. Brush should be in bundles no larger than 2 ft. by 4 ft.
- Rumpke will provide for the curbside collection of **one large or bulky trash item** on your regular weekly collection day. Residents should call Hidden Valley Lake at **812-537-3091** to schedule large item pick up **48 hours in advance of collection day.**
- Freon containing items such as refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners will only be collected if a certified CFC removal sticker is placed on it. See your local heating and air conditioning service provider for information regarding CFC removal.

## RECYCLING

- Rumpke will provide each single-family residence with a 14 gallon recycling bin at no charge. Please place your recycling bin at the curb the night before your scheduled Friday pick up. Available at HVL POA office, two bins maximum.

### Newspapers and Mixed Paper

Newspapers with glossy ad inserts, magazines, catalogs and telephone books should be placed together in a brown paper grocery sack. Place sack inside or beside your bin, or in case of rain, place under the bin. Cardboard must be flat and no larger than 3' x 3'. No waxy coating. **Not accepted are pizza boxes. Grease and food contamination render them unacceptable.**

### Plastics

Plastic milk containers, soft drink, shampoo, laundry and detergent bottles displaying the recycling logo with the number 1 or 2. Please remove all caps or lids and rinse. **Not presently accepted are wide-mouth containers such as margarine bowls or whipped topping containers, plastic flatware, cassette and compact disc cases, children's toys, oil jugs, plastic bags, plastic buckets and garden hoses. Non-food packaging, including Styrofoam packing peanuts, will not be accepted.**

### Glass

Clear, brown, green and blue glass food and beverage containers and jars are accepted. Please remove caps and rinse. Paper labels do not need to be removed. Metal lids can be placed in bin. **Not presently accepted are window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, drinking glasses or mugs, and oven/cooking glassware.**

### Beverage & Steel Food Cans

Aluminum cans, steel soup and food cans, and empty aerosol cans are accepted. Please rinse and drain. Lids may be placed in cans. **Not presently accepted are pots or pans, coat hangers and scrap steel.**
