

Interested in Frisbee Disc Golf?

Disc Golf is a fast growing outdoor activity that everyone can enjoy. Similar to golf, the object of Disc Golf is to complete each hole in as few throws, or strokes, as possible. Instead of using golf clubs or a golf ball, disc golfers use a flying golf disc or “Frisbee” to traverse each hole. Each hole starts with a teeing area and is completed once the disc lands in the “hole”, which is a disc-catching basket. The natural surrounding and geographical layout are what make a course both challenging and beautiful.

Disc Gold is an economical sport for all to enjoy and it can be played from school age to Golden age; making it a terrific lifetime sport and form of exercise. Disc golf is an inexpensive recreational activity accessible to the entire community. For the fraction of the cost of other activities we can build our own HVL Disc Golf course that will serve up to 72 people at a time from dawn to dusk. This course will utilize space in the 77 acres that are typically not used by other activities. Holes can be routed through woods, over hills, across fields and streams and near lakes. Some of these isolated areas attract unsavory and unwanted activities. Adding a Disc Golf course will increase foot traffic, thus helping to reduce unwanted behaviors in the area.
